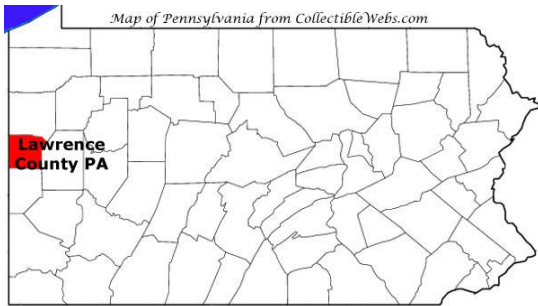


Where is Villa Maria?

Villa Maria now encompasses 726 acres of picturesque farmland, wetlands, forest, a bird sanctuary and nature trails. It is also home to a small herd of cattle and a flock of sheep. Villa Maria Farm produces food for residents and guests of Villa Maria Community Center as well as people served by food banks and outreach programs in the area. Volunteers work on the organic farm and nature trails in the earth spirituality ministry.
